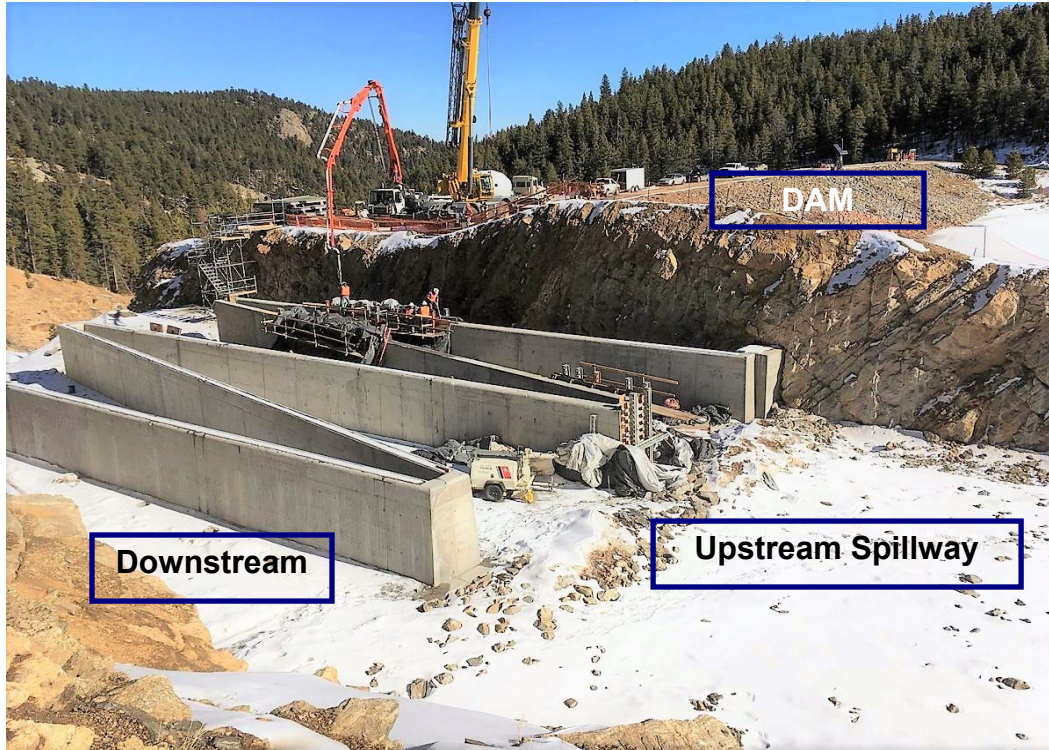

Upper Beaver Brook Capacity Improvement Project

The project is expected to be substantially complete in May 2017.

The project remains on schedule and under budget. The water level is slowly starting to rise, due to careful management and planning of our water sources and exchanges. We cannot currently predict whether the new capacity will fill to 100% this year, but with strong snowpack levels this season, we are hopeful to refill the reservoir to the old high level water mark or above. The new labyrinth walls will be ready! Special thanks to Director Dean Snyder for the many, many volunteer hours he has logged to keep this project going so well. The Board also thanks GEI Consultants and SEMA Construction for safe and excellent work.
