If you consume ...	2017	2016
0 to 3,000 gallons of water your bill will be:	\$36.14	\$32.93
4,000 gallons of water your bill will be:	\$54.20	\$49.39
5,000 gallons of water your bill will be:	\$78.29	\$71.34
6,000 gallons of water your bill will be:	\$108.41	\$98.78
7,000 gallons of water your bill will be:	\$144.54	\$131.71
8,000 gallons of water your bill will be:	\$186.70	\$170.12

## Looking Ahead

It's time to register those Laterals again! Registration Forms are due in the district office by January 31, 2017 per Lookout Mountain Water District Rules & Regulation: (please find registration form on the web site or call the office )

The owners of each privately owned lateral system shall submit a report on an annual basis to the Administrator which shall provide the following original or updated information with regard to the line and its ownership:

1. Name, address and form of organization, and directors or officers.
2. Emergency contact names and telephone numbers.
3. Copy of most recent update of by-laws, rules and regulations of the lateral owners' organization, including policy on extending service to new taps.
4. Current financial statements of the lateral owners' organization.

On October 10, the LMWD Board approved a policy by Resolution with regard to Inactive Taps. The policy is located on our website and these tap owners will receive a personal letter.
